DR. JÓZEF KOTOWICZ

JÓZEF KOTOWICZ graduated from the F. Chopin Music Academy (Branch in Białystok, Poland) and then continued his education in Warsaw, Poland in the organ class of Professor J. Serafin. In 2001 he was awarded a doctoral degree from the Music Academy in Warsaw.

Mr. Kotowicz participates in numerous festivals in Poland and abroad (Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Germany, USA, and Slovakia). He is the producer of a radio broadcast series devoted to organs of Northeast Poland, of recordings made for Polish television, and has recorded compact discs of the organ in the Cathedral Basilica (Białystok).

Mr. Kotowicz works with the Białystok Philharmonic Society, taking part in oratorio concerts and is artistic director of Cathedral Organ Concerts in Białystok as well as several festivals in the Białystok region. He is a teacher at the I.J. Paderewski 2nd Grade State Music School (organ performance and improvisation), acts as organist in St. Adalbertus Church, and is chairman of Białystok's Association Musica Sacra.
